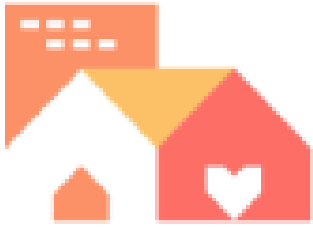
### Updates
