We are halfway through the first half-term! Time seems to have flown by over the last four and a half weeks. The children have all settled in so well and are working brilliantly all together. They should be proud of all the learning they have done so far!

This week, the KS2 have completed writing their narratives. Year 3 worked hard to include adjectives and adverbs while Y5/6 included lots of different sentence openers and description. In maths, lots of the children have been using number lines and comparing numbers., Year 5 has been brilliant at rounding! In art, KS1 learnt how to create shades of a colour while KS2 planned their mosaic design.

In science, all the children were learning through investigation. KS1 were making predictions about different smells and went on a sound walk. Year 3 investigated which materials were magnetic and were intrigued to find some 2p coins were magnetic and some weren't! Year 5/6 learnt about air resistance by investigating how the size of parachute affects the time taken to fall.

Harvest

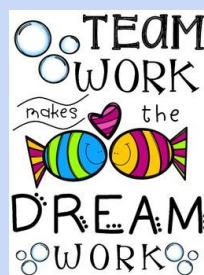
