**Writing:**  
In English this half term the children will be writing narrative based on the story 'Escape from Pompeii'. They will also be writing a biography of a significant person and learning and writing poetry using language play. In SPAG, the children will be learning about punctuation and word classes.

**Reading:**  
This term the children will either continue with RWI or they will take part in weekly guided reading and whole class reading sessions. They will learn how to retrieve from the text.  
**Please read 5 times a week at home.**

**Mathematics:**  
Year 3 will be learning about place value of 3 digit numbers before moving on to addition and subtraction using 3 digit numbers.  
Year 5 will be learning about place value of 5 and 6 digit numbers, addition and subtraction and number properties such as factors and primes.  
Year 6 will be learning about place value and the 4 operations.

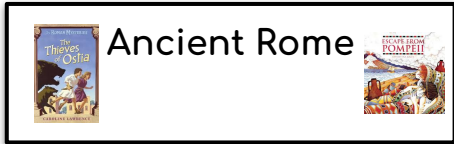
